Philharmonic Choir sings 'Music for the Masses'

The Durham Philharmonic Choir is celebrating its 25th Anniversary Season with another special program on April 8, 2018 at 3PM. The concert features 2 spectacular works by leading British composers Karl Jenkins and John Rutter. Jenkins' GLORIA is an exhilarating work that draws on texts from religions and cultures throughout the world which is typical of his diverse and inclusive approach to composing. A recent survey indicates that Jenkins is now the most performed living composer in the world.

Rutter's REQUIEM is one of the most beloved works in the classical choral repertoire. Rutter has been referred to as the most gifted composer of his generation. The REQUIEM is a testament to his popularity the world over – in the first 6 months after its publication the work received over 500 performances in America alone.

The concert will once again include a stellar orchestra. Brooklin, ON resident and frequent soloist with the DPC, Brittany King will be featured for the soprano solo movements in each work.

The concert takes place Sunday, April 8, 2018, 3PM at College Park Church, 1164 King St. East, Oshawa.
